



Word Bank

This word bank contains words that are decodable. This means that the words included contain only the letters for the speech sounds as they have been taught. As you teach each sound and the letter that represents the sound, you can increase the number of words that can be read and written.

- Column one relates to the letter/s representing the sound.
- Column two, beginners, relates to the easiest words that can be constructed with the letters taught so far.
- The intermediate words include words with consonant clusters and require a greater level of challenge to read and write
- The final column relates to words with two or more consonant clusters and or multisyllabic words.

We encourage you to start at the beginner's level and then increase the complexity as your child grows in confidence in their reading and writing ability.
